Teaching your child to speak, read, and write in English.

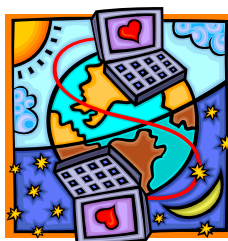
Through our SEI programs for English language learners at all of our schools, we offer the following opportunities:
