Arrival and Dismissal

Start time is 7:45 AM and dismissal is 2:45 PM.

Early Release Wednesdays

Dismissal time is 12:45 every Wednesday

Car pick-up and drop-off

Kindergarten students will be dropped off and picked up in the back of the school. First grade through third grade students will be dropped off and picked up in the front of the school. Families who have a kindergarten student and an older sibling will be dropped off and picked up in the back of the school. When picking up and dropping off, pull all the way forward and stay in your car.

The drop off window is **7:25–7:45**. The gates will be locked at 7:45 A.M. Students who arrive tardy must be signed in by an adult at the front office. Families who drop off children in the back of the school and arrive after 7:45, must drive around to the front of the school to drop off and sign their children in.


The pick up window is **2:45–3:00**, Wednesdays **12:45 –1:00**. Families who arrive after the pickup window time will need to park and enter the front office to pick up their children.

If you are picking up your child early ensure it is anytime before 2:15, Wednesdays 12:15.

Otherwise we can not call into classrooms as it disrupts the end of the day for the entire classroom.

Walking pick-up and drop-off

Parents may also walk up to the school to drop off and pick up at designated stations. Notify your child's teacher if you would like your child to be sent to the walking pick-up station for this school year so it can be noted on their transportation information. Kindergarten walking pick-up is at the back of the school. Ist-3rd walking pick-up is at the front of the school. If you are driving and then walking up please park in a parking space, use the crosswalk and bring your placard.





Masks Optional

Masks are optional. If you would like for your child to wear a mask, be sure to send a mask with your child.

Uniforms Optional & Dress Code

Uniforms are optional however, attire must be appropriate for school activities.

If opting not to wear a uniform, student attire should facilitate participation in learning in the classroom, playground and gym.

- Shoes must be closed-toe. For safety reasons, no platform shoes, slippers, or sandals. Students play on equipment during recess that can result in serious injury. Athletic/tennis shoes are required for the day your child has Physical Education (P.E.) class.
- Shorts, dresses, skirts, rompers and jumpers should be worn as close to the knee as possible.
- Shirts must appropriately cover the torso.
- Clothing items cannot display words or graphics that promote illegal, violent, or vulgar conduct.
- Hats may be worn to school. Hats are permissible outside only.

If opting to wear a uniform, traditionally our uniform consists of the following:

- Pants/Shorts/Skirts/Dresses: Navy blue or Khaki
- Polo-style shirt (pull-over, collared shirts): Navy blue, Light blue, White

School Supplies

Most school supplies are provided by the school. Your child's teacher may send home a list of items that are greatly appreciated. We do encourage students to have a backpack to transport items to and from school.





On Site After School Care

Phoenix Afterschool Center (PAC) will resume and be available citywide for this school year. Registration opens **July 13, 2021 at noon** and fills up fast. Registration is available on a first-come, first-served basis and a waitlist will be available. To participate in the PAC program, participants must be at least six years old by the session start date or enrolled in 1st grade.
