**Discussion/Information Items**

**Update on School Closure and Reopening**

Dr. Robert shared data from the dashboard on the Maricopa County website displayed by zip code both within the district boundaries and for those surrounding areas where students and staff reside. Beginning with areas within the district boundaries, Dr. Robert reviewed the benchmarks focusing on the number of cases and the percent positivity. Numbers have risen in zip codes both in and surrounding the district. Similarly, other elementary districts are also seeing a rise in numbers with 6 districts in red indicating substantial community spread as compared to 3 the previous week.

Dr. Robert explained that the district has limited its offering of targeted assistance to no more than twice weekly and in anticipation of moving into red may need to further reduce the classes. Supervised Independent Learning Spaces (SILS) cannot be closed. Asking for input from members, Dr. Robert said that Admin Team will be discussing the best options for moving forward but would like to include input from the Board in those discussions. Members expressed support for decisions that are focused on safety. Dr. Robert shared that there are parents who are not happy with the decision to have not returned to in person learning. Reminding members that not all functions of the district can be done remotely, he stated that many functions require staff to be on the front lines and environments are only as safe as the mitigation. Mr. Flamand questioned the number of staff at each site with principals Nickolich, Norwood and Grose stating that about ¾ of their staff are on site, principals Carranza and Hayes have minimal staff, 2-4 and Site Administrator Kelly has about 14 staff on site. In response to Mr. Flamand's question about protective measures, Dr. Robert explained that movement around campuses is only done when necessary and when staff meet or talk with another person they mask up.
